Climate Requirement: Cauliflower prefer cooler conditions with night temperatures of 8-12C and mild days < 22C producing best results, other conditions will be tolerated so long as the day / night differential is not more than 12C and maximum <30C

Frost Sensitivity: Frosts can be tolerated but will slow maturity. Severe cold conditions early in the season may also be detrimental to final yield.
