## **Royal Crown**

Hybrid Beit Alpha Cucumber



- Trialled as TCL5149
- Uniform fruit, dark green with good ribbing
- Medium open plant easy to manage
- Suited to warm production, semi-multi set
- Good quality no neck
- Good disease tolerance to CVYV, CMV, ZYMV, PRSV, Px, Ccu.





In the SmartQ varieties a polygenic resistance of the plant against the three major viruses has been developed.

SmartQ varieties are improved cucumber lines that provides fruit quality in a more resistant plant.

Thus, the SmartQ lines develop:

- more open plants with short internodes
- smaller and darker leaves
- a more horizontal orientation of the leaves
- smaller flowers and more flowers per internode.



SmartQ range Cucumber



- Open plant with smaller leaves
- Plant structure is very suitable for easier light penetration
- Short internodes and small, horizontal leaf
- Dark green and ribbed fruit maintaining the size through the cropping cycle
- HR: Ccu; IR: CVYV / CYSDV / Px.

#### **Caronte**

### Hybrid Cucumber



- Recommended for Spring and Autumn production
- Strong plant that produces an abundance of dark green fruit
- Good disease tolerance to PM; CVYV and CYSDV.

#### **Carranza**

#### Hybrid Cucumber



- Quality, dark green fruit with an attractive rib
- Produces good length in cool conditions
- Disease resistance CVYV and CYSDV.

#### Hybrid Cucumber




- Adaptability in adverse conditions; Quality and Production

- Easy to grow in all conditions
- Excellent shape and dark green coloured fruit
- Fruit length 30 35cm

#### **Barcelona**

#### Hybrid Eggplant



- Compact, open plant with early production
- Large teardrop shaped fruit with smooth, glossy, dark skin
- Firm flesh with small, light seeds
- Small spineless calyx
- Productive variety suitable for open field conditions
- Strong, upright bush.

#### Lisbon


#### Hybrid Eggplant



- Medium erect habit plant
- Compact plant with very early production
- Excellent setting under hot conditions
- Round shape fruit smooth shiny black colour.
   Firm seedless flesh. Small, green spineless calyx
- Productive variety adapted to greenhouse and open field conditions.

#### Cosmos

#### Hybrid Eggplant



- Medium erect open plant habit
- Sets with ease throughout the plant cycle, well suited to long cycles
- Oval-long shape, fruit are spineless
- Length 21-22cm x 7- 8cm
- Very dark glossy colour that is maintained throughout the cycle
- Average fruit weight 410-430g
- Approx 75 days to maturity.

#### **Orestia**

#### Hybrid Eggplant



- Vigorous plant, with short internodes and good leaf cover
- Fruit are very uniform, with very good gloss black colour
- Fruit are firm, spineless and semi long
- Fruit dimensions 23-24cm x 6-7cm
- Typical fruit size range is 450-500g
- Suitable for spring-summer cultivation in tunnel houses.

### **Fedele**

### Hybrid Tomato



- More quality to a great postharvest
- Open and strong plant type
- Excellent yields as a result of consistent fruit setting and uniform size
- Short internodes
- Bright red colour
- Very long shelf life due to tolerance to cracking
- Suitable for both cluster harvest and single picking
- The clusters are long with 12 to 16 fruit with a very elegant calyx
- HR: ToMV / Fol: 0, 1 / Pf: A-E
- IR: TYLCV / Ma / Mi / Mj.

### **Ferdinand**

Hybrid Grape Tomato



- Sensational eating quality super sweet flavour due to brix over 8
- Vigorous open plant with a generative habit
- High fruit numbers as it easily splits the truss
- Uniform grape shaped fruit, size 15-20g
- Early maturing, with excellent shelf life
- Disease resistance: HR: ToMV 0-2; IR: TYLCV.
